It is our hope that you will meet Jesus in a fresh way in the next hour & know Him more through prayer.

We are going to read through some scriptures that will focus on specific characteristics of Jesus:

- Faithfulness
- Wisdom
- Humility
- Servanthood





Before we do that, let's spend a few minutes dealing with something that many times is a barrier to prayer... DOUBT.

It is human nature to question, to wrestle, to doubt, to struggle. If there has been something you have been struggling with — such as doubt — this is a safe place to talk it out with Jesus.

Please feel free to write this out or talk it out, however you need to do it. Doubt is a part of being human. It stretches us. But working with Jesus to overcome our doubts can lead us to deeper faith!



"Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding. In all your ways, surrender to Him, and He will make your paths straight."

When you surrender, you determine that He is Lord and you are not. Surrender leads to learning more of God's faithfulness.

Let's jump in...



Faithfulness is our first characteristic in knowing Jesus more. Faithfulness denotes firmness or constancy of God. God cannot lie. He cannot break a promise. He cannot fail!

PSALM 119:90

"Your faithfulness extends to every generation, as enduring as the earth you created."

JOSHUA 21:45

"Not one of all the Lord's good promises to Israel failed, every one was fulfilled."

PSALM 36:5

"Your love, Lord, reaches to the heavens, your faithfulness to the skies."


Consider God's faithfulness in your own life.

Many of us think that God removing the hard things in life is equal to His faithfulness. But, it actually grows our faith more when we realize that God's faithfulness is greatest in times of struggle or hardship. When we need to trust Him to lead us through the fire. The book of Isaiah says we will walk through the fire and not be burned!

PROVERBS 15:33


"The fear of the Lord teaches wisdom, humility precedes honor."

A servant is "one who serves another." To serve is "to be humble before God." "To be devoted and helpful."

Jesus was a servant. In John 13, Jesus washes His disciple's feet. In Luke 22, Jesus serves His disciples at the last supper.

JOHN 3:16

"For God so loved the world He gave his only son, that whoever believes in him will not perish but have eternal life."

MATTHEW 23:11

"The greatest among you will be a servant."

Have you noticed yet? To truly be a servant like Jesus was, we need humility, wisdom, and faithfulness to all work together.




Let's spend our last few minutes praying about how we can be more of a servant in our families, workplaces, marriages, neighborhoods, and in the Church.
